







AT A GLANCE

EDU-SYRIA is a series of EU-funded projects through the EU Regional Trust Fund in Response to the Syrian Crisis (Madad Fund), and the Neighbourhood Instrument (ENI), which are managed by the German Jordanian University.

EDU-SYRIA aims to improve the livelihoods of Syrian refugees and vulnerable Jordanians, who are beneficiaries from the local charity organizations; National Aid Fund, Tkiyet Um Ali, Zakat Fund and Al Aman Fund, through access to higher and vocational education and improvement of employability.

The project consists of 4 projects:



EDU-SYRIA I started in 2015



EDU-SYRIA II started in 2016



EDU-SYRIA II Additional started in 2019



and lastly **EDU-SYRIA III** started in 2020.



The European Union funded EDU-SYRIA with 32.6 Million Euro in total so far.

CORE OBJECTIVES

The Programme, in partnership with Nuffic, funds 12 sub-projects implemented by local institutions, that will provide different TVET programs to support the target groups in 3 transition stages; after High school, during undergrad studies, after graduation.



The Programme aspires to equip teams with the necessary competencies and abilities to establish 40 start-ups, in addition to providing seed capital to launch their start-up businesses.



The Programme supports Jordanian teachers by offering 180 Teacher Education Professional Diploma scholarships.



The Programme seeks to develop the skills of Syrian refugees and vulnerable Jordanian students by offering short labour market oriented courses that provide them with the required knowledge and skills to access the labour market.



The Programme aims to provide more than 3000 higher education scholarships(bachelor's degree, master's degree, andvocational diploma).
