



EDU -SYRIA IV for Graduate Studies Scholarship Program Funded by the EU

Scholarship Announcement for Syrians

EDU-SYRIA IV program for graduate studies is part of a broader project that includes a range of other programs. It is funded by the EU and implemented by DAAD as part of a consortium led by German Jordanian University (GJU), with a mission to find talented Syrian refugee youths and develop them further by providing them with a rewarding opportunity to study to obtain a master's degree. Therefore, they have the ability to lead and advance their career and consequently better productive livelihood. The scholarship is offering (5) master's degree scholarship opportunities for Syrians at the German Jordanian University in various humanitarian and engineering fields, starting from the first academic semester 2025/2026.

The deadline for submission of applications is August 31st 2025 at 12am

I. Support from the Scholarship Program

- The scholarship will cover the tuition and registration fees for a maximum of four semesters, as well as a one-time admission fees.
- A stipend of 400 Euro will be awarded once per semester to cover basic expenses such as books. (only for four semesters)
- Scholarship recipients will receive maximal administrative support throughout the program of study.

II. Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the scholarship, the applicant shall meet the following:

- 1. Being a Syrian refugee who currently lives in Jordan.
- 2. Have Asylum Seeker Certificate-ASC (UNHCR-issued documentation).
- 3. Have a valid magnetic Ministry of the Interior Service-MOI card.
- 4. Not over 28 years of age at the start date of the intended master's degree program.
- 5. Grade Point Average (GPA) of the undergraduate degree in the relevant program must be at least **"Very Good"** or higher.
- 6. Submitting a valid (not older than 2 years) IELTS or TOEFL result with the required band/score (as per the chosen university and the program requirements) will prioritize your application and significantly increase your chances of acceptance.

- 7. <u>Please note</u> that your chosen master's program must be consecutive, meaning it should be directly related to and build on your Bachelor's studies. As the scholarship will not cover any expenses for prerequisite or deficiency courses.
- Women are encouraged to apply.
- Persons with special challenges/special needs are encouraged to apply.
- No work experience is required.
- The applicant who is already enrolled in a master's program, or has another scholarship, or has been previously either dropped out or dismissed from EDU-SYRIA Graduate Studies Scholarship Program, will be immediately excluded from the scholarship.

III. Application and Required Documents

The applicant has to prepare and submit the following documents:

- Completed scholarship application form, which is available on: https://edu-sys.eu/EduSyriaScholarship/EduSyria/Login
- 2. A copy of the applicant's Asylum Seeker Certificate-ASC.
- 3. A copy of the applicant's valid Ministry of the Interior Service (MOI) card.
- 4. A copy of the applicant's high school diploma (Tawjihi or equivalent).
- 5. A copy of the Bachelor's degree certificate.
- 6. A copy of your transcript of records with all individual grades and semesters.
- 7. A curriculum vitae (CV)/resume in English that outlines educational background and research experience, if any.
- 8. A recent applicant's photograph.
- 9. An English Language Proficiency test; TOEFL or IELTS; in accordance to the required band/score of your chosen program. (priority will be given to those who submit it)

IV. Supported Field of Study and Corresponding Universities

Obtained admission for a master's program will be accepted as long as it was granted only by the German Jordanian University from one of the programs listed on page no. 4 of this document.















I. Selection Process

The selection process consists of two rounds:

A. Round 1: Initial Application Screening

After the scholarship application deadline, an initial eligibility screening will be conducted to ensure that the applications meet all the pre-determined requirements. Following the screening, interview appointments will be scheduled and sent to eligible applicants. Priority will be given to students with higher GPAs and with IELTS or TOEFL results during this process.

B. Round 2: Interview

The **Scholarship Selection Committee** will conduct the Interview Round using a blend of Arabic and English for each candidate face-to-face if circumstances permit.

Each applicant will be scored based on their performance during the interview.

After passing the Interview Round, candidates who have not had a letter of admission from any targeted universities, DAAD will apply for them to be admitted in the targeted university/field of study master's program of their choice (for the supported fields please check pages (5-9) of this document.

<u>Note:</u> Applicants who have already obtained an admission offer from a targeted university to study one of the supported fields do need to continue the application process along with submitting the required documents.

All applicants to the Scholarship Program will be notified of results before the start of the first semester 25/26.

C. Selection Criteria:

The application and selection process of EDU-SYRIA IV Graduate Studies program is open, competitive, transparent, and free of charge. Members of the Selection Committee are prominent professors in various fields of science and technology and humanities. Applicants do not need to pay any fees to anyone in order to apply for the scholarship. Scholarship recipients are selected based on vulnerability, individual merit, including academic performance in addition to their English proficiency, preparation, intellectual capability, potential, courage/resilience, and commitment to contribute to the development of humanity, science, and technology which will be assessed during the interview phase.















D. Scholarship Conditions

Applicants must fully meet the application requirements of the scholarship. During the study program, applicants must meet all the academic requirements determined by the program as well as reporting their academic performance and research progress periodically to the Scholarship Program mentor.
